



1 INSTALL FAUCET

CAUTION

Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.


 Install FAUCET (1) on lavatory. (No sealant is required unless mounting deck on lavatory is uneven).



2 SECURE FAUCET AND MAKE WATER SUPPLY CONNECTIONS


- NOTE: Flexible supplies have to be purchased separately.
- Secure FAUCET (1) with ATTACHMENT NUTS (2) supplied. (HAND TIGHTEN).
- Connect water supply to FAUCET (1) with 1/2" IPS FLEXIBLE SUPPLIES (3) or 3/8" O.D. BULL-NOSE RISERS (4). Use adjustable wrench to tighten connections. Do not over tighten. Be careful not to kink copper supply when bending. Use tubing cutter to cut to proper length.

(HAND TIGHTEN)



3 TEST INSTALLED FAUCET

- Remove AERATOR. With handles in OFF position, turn on water supplies and check all connections for leaks.
- Operate both handles to flush water lines thoroughly. Replace AERATOR.



4 SERVICE

CAUTION

Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

If Faucet Drips, Proceed As Follows:


- Turn HANDLES to OFF position.
- If spout drips, operate HANDLES several times from OFF to ON position. Do not force HANDLES they turn only 90°.
- AERATOR may accumulate dirt causing distorted and reduced water flow. Remove AERATOR and clean before reinstalling.

Change Handle Direction:

- Lift up HANDLE (1).
- Remove Plastic ADAPTER (2) and CARTRIDGE NUT (3).
- Lift and turn STOP WASHER 90°.
- Re-install HANDLE components.


To Change Cartridge:

- Lift up HANDLE (1).
- Remove Plastic ADAPTER (2) and CARTRIDGE NUT (3).
- Lift CARTRIDGE (4) off PORT (5).
- Clean CARTRIDGE (4) port.
- Place CARTRIDGE (4) onto PORT (5) and tighten CARTRIDGE NUT (3) alternately.
- Replace Plastic ADAPTER (2), HANDLE (1).



6 CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

DO: SIMPLY RINSE THE PRODUCT CLEAN WITH CLEAR WATER. DRY WITH A SOFT COTTON FLANNEL CLOTH. DO NOT: DO NOT CLEAN THE PRODUCT WITH SOAPS, ACID, POLISH, ABRASIVES, HARSH CLEANERS, OR A CLOTH WITH A COARSE SURFACE.
