- a. WP3201-EXT . . . External Corner—1 corner
- b. WP3212-EXT . . . External Corner—12 corners

General Product Description

- a. a rugged, flexible, pre-formed corner tape for covering joints to prevent penetration of moisture and provide a sound foundation for tile or stone overlayments
- b. anti-fracture protection between substrates and hard surface coverings
- c. embed with TANK/10® waterproofing compound

Physical Characteristics

- a. pre-formed, seamless external corners
- b. impermeable
- c. stretches
- d. material composition: substrate two outer layers of polypropylene non-woven; membrane one inner layer of polyurethane waterproofing membrane
- e. color: gray
- f. length of each leg: 41/4"
- g. width of each bottom leg: 23/8"
- h. height: 31/2" at center; 23/8" at ends
- i. thickness: .5mm

Performance Characteristics

- a. a seamless, flexible tape for waterproofing external corner joints
- b. embed with TANK/10® waterproofing compound
- c. use to cover joints between ARC shower bases and surrounding tile underlayment materials
- d. use where three surfaces interface at 90°
- e. provides substantial stretch characteristics for seasonal material movement and crack mitigation
- f. fill gaps beneath tape that are 1/8" wide or more using latex caulk or thinset mortar (do not use silicone)
- g. remove all dirt, debris, and contaminants from surfaces prior to embedding tape
- h. surfaces must be completely dry before embedding tape
- i. tape is not designed as a wear surface; cover with tile, stone, or other appropriate material
